

Robert Biber, Government Commissioner for Maritime Affairs

Robert Biber was appointed Government Commissioner for Maritime Affairs on May 1st, 2008 and he has been the Luxembourg representative on the EMSA Administrative Board since March 12th, 2009. The agency he is heading is the focal point of all shipping matters in Luxembourg.

Prior to his current function Mr. Biber was head of public relations at the ministry of the Economy and Foreign trade.

From 2001 to 2007, he was Consul General of Luxembourg and Executive Director of the Luxembourg Board of Economic Development (1) in San Francisco, California.

He was a Lieutenant-Colonel in the Luxembourg Army and from 1988 to 2000 he served as Aide-de-Camp to H.R.H. Crown Prince Henri of Luxembourg (2). In this function, Mr. Biber accompanied the Crown Prince on numerous economic missions all over the world.

Mr. Biber was born in 1959 and is married with three children.
