Step 2 – (Restricted) "Invitation to Tender"







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

Lot 2: Northern Black Sea


The Northern Black Sea area limited by the coastline of Bulgaria and Romania and by the 32° meridian east

Indicative capacity: 1,250 m³

Minimum capacity/vessel: 700 m³

Flashpoint: Below 60°C

> Budget: <u>€ 4.0 m</u> + Equipment transfer

- 2 x Sweeping arm
- 2 x 250m booms
- Offshore skimmer
- High-capacity skimmer
- Slick detection system
- Additional small equipment



Lot 3: Channel and Southern North Sea

Southern coastline of the United Kingdom from Lands' End to Hull and the European Continental coastline from Esbjerg (Denmark) to Donges (France)

Indicative capacity: 1,250 m³

Minimum capacity/vessel: 700 m³

> Budget: <u>€ 3.3 m</u> + Equipment transfer + Purchase









Lot 4: Northern North Sea and Norwegian Sea


Western coastline of Norway, the Faroe Islands the southern coast of Iceland and limited by the 25° meridian west and between 58° and 65° parallel north.

Indicative capacity: 1,250 m³

Minimum capacity/vessel: 700 m³

Flashpoint: Below 60°C

> Budget: <u>€ 5.4 m</u> + Equipment transfer + Purchase



Presenting an Application to EMSA


- Two sealed envelopes (one inside the other)
- One submission per lot, i.e., different lot ifferent envelope
- Submission of 1 original paper copy of the application + electronic copy to <u>NEG12014@emsa.europa.eu</u>
- Justification for non-inclusion of requested documentation
- Applications can be in any official language of the EU (preferably in English)
- Point 10.6: General Description of Proposed Arrangement: must include copy in English
- Separation of documentation into <u>Parts A E (as per the Checklist)</u>





Point 9 - Requirements as to the application

PART A:



- Signed Cover Letter: Specify person heading project (9.A.1);
- "Statement of Subcontracting/Joint Offer" in case of grouping (9.A.2);
- Signed document authorising person to submit application & sign contract (original) (9.A.3);
- Legal Entity Form (9.A.4): EACH company to complete "Legal Entity Form" (original) together with "attachments" (copies):
 - Official Registration Document (Official Gazette, Company Register, etc.);
 - VAT Registration Document (if not included in the above-mentioned document).
- Financial Identification Form: filled and signed by the account holder and the bank (9.A.5).



Point 9 - Requirements as to the application

PART B:

Declaration on Honour: completed and signed by EACH company (9.B.6);

or alternatively

- Additional proof (10.3) Exclusion Criteria (per member of grouping):
 - (a), (b) or (e) Extract from judicial record OR Equivalent doc by authority showing requirements satisfied;
 - (d) Certificate from competent authority of State concerned OR If no certificate issued, Sworn/Solemn Statement before judicial authority or notary etc;
 - (c), (f) checked by EMSA or requests for further information.

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Point 9 - Requirements as to the application

<u>PART C:</u> Documents for proving the Economic and Financial Capacity (per member of grouping) (Point 10.4):

Information for last 3 financial years (closed accounts):

Balance sheets (9.C.7);

or

• Statement of overall turnover and Profit and Loss account (9.C.8)

Annual budget for last year (for semi-public or non-profit organisations) (9.C.8).

Evaluated according to International Rating Practice

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Preparing the Application

Point 9 - Requirements as to the application

PART D: Technical and professional capacity criteria of Company/Consortium (10.5)

- Document of Compliance (DoC) for International Safety Management (ISM) Code including the related latest external audit (9.D.9);
 - Grouping: at least 1 member must have a valid DOC
- Overview of company/consortium Port State Control record (PSC inspections and detentions) or annual Flag Surveys for last 3 years 3 detentions will be ground for exclusion (9.D.10);
- Where applicable, additional list of relevant services for last 5 years (9.D.11);
 - Grouping: criteria evaluated as a group, not individually



Point 9 - Requirements as to the application

PART E: General Description of the proposed arrangement (10.6)

- General description of the arrangement (9.E.12);
- Vessel(s) identification and characteristics: IMO number, heating, pumping, and storage capacities, speed, GA plan (9.E.13);
- Usual area of operation & economic activity (9.E.14);
- Proposed location of any response equipment stockpiles (9.E.15);
- Draft mobilisation plan (9.E.16).
