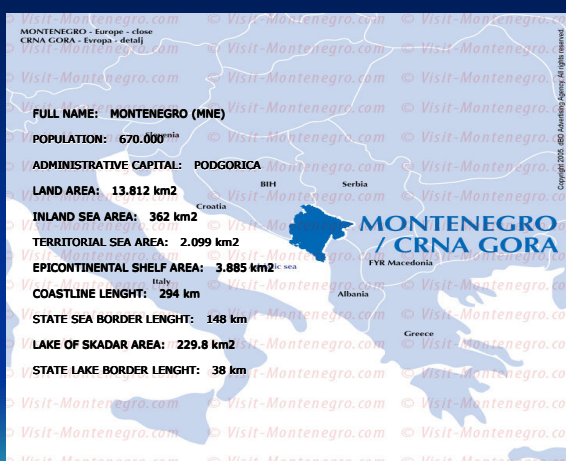

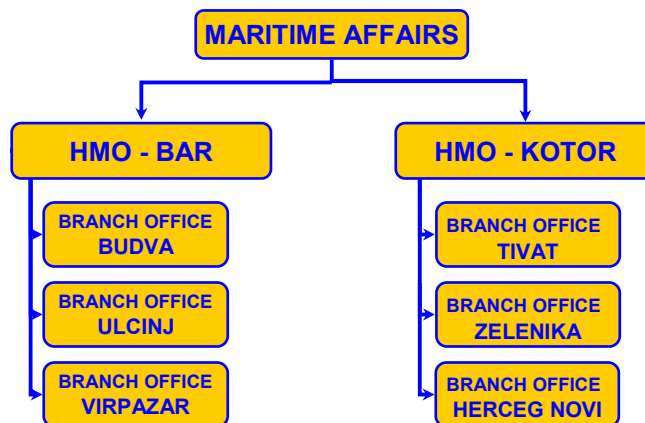
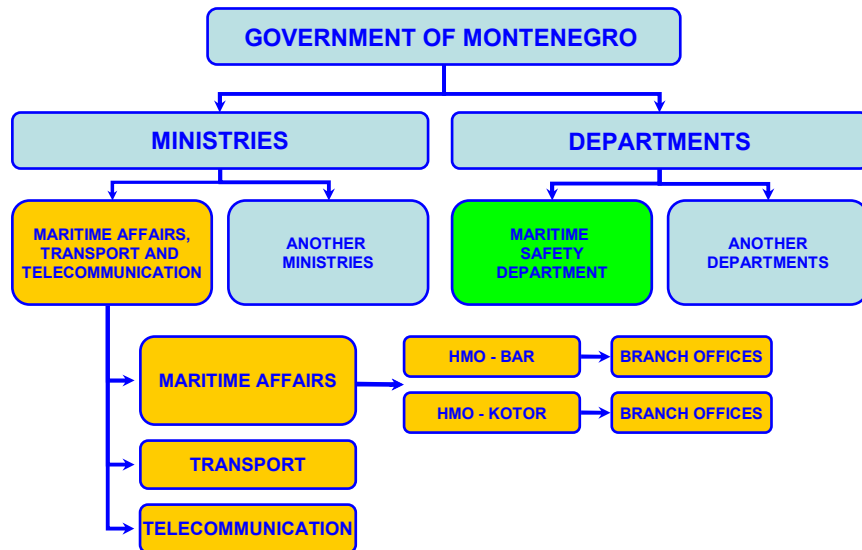

## MONTENEGRO MARITIME ORGANIZATION



PERFORMS ACTIVITIES REGARDING:

- PORT STATE CONTROL INSPECTION;
- SEAFARERS EXAMINATIONS, ON WHICH BASE CERTIFICATES AS PER STCW CODE TO SEAFARERS, ARE ISSUED;
- REGISTRATION OF SHIPS, FISHING VESSELS, BOATS AND ISSUING CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRY.

## MARITIME SAFETY DEPARTMENT

MARITIME SAFETY DEPARTMENT IS A MONTENEGRO STATE ADMINISTRATION BODY AND PERFORMS ACTIVITIES IN THE FIELD OF ESTABLISHING SEAWORTHINESS OF SHIPS AND OTHER NAVIGABLE AND FLOATING VESSELS AND, BASED ON THESE ISSUES, APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATES ( BOTH INTERNATIONAL AND NATIONAL).

ALSO, MARITIME SAFETY DEPARTMENT PERFORMS RADIO SERVICE FOR THE PROTECTION OF LIVES AT SEA, SEARCH AND RESCUE ACTIVITIES, REGULATION AND MAINTENANCE OF NAVIGABLE WATERWAYS AND INSTALLMENT OF AIDS TO NAVIGATION STRUCTURES, YACHT REGISTRATION AS WELL AS ACTIVITIES CONNECTED WITH PREVENTION OF SEA POLLUTION FROM SHIPS.

CONTROL OVER LEGALITY OF THESE ACTIVITIES IS PERFORMED BY THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT, MARITIME AFFAIRS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS OF MONTENEGRO.

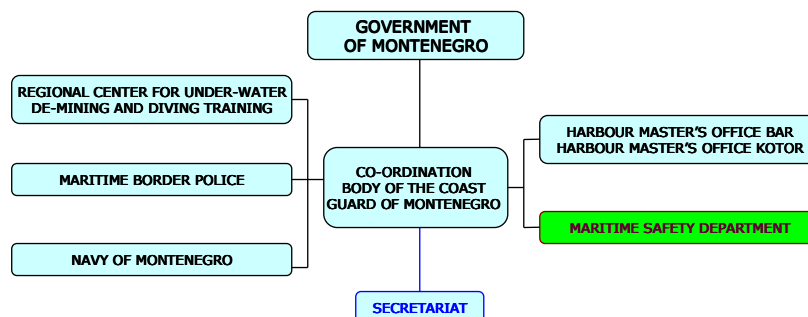

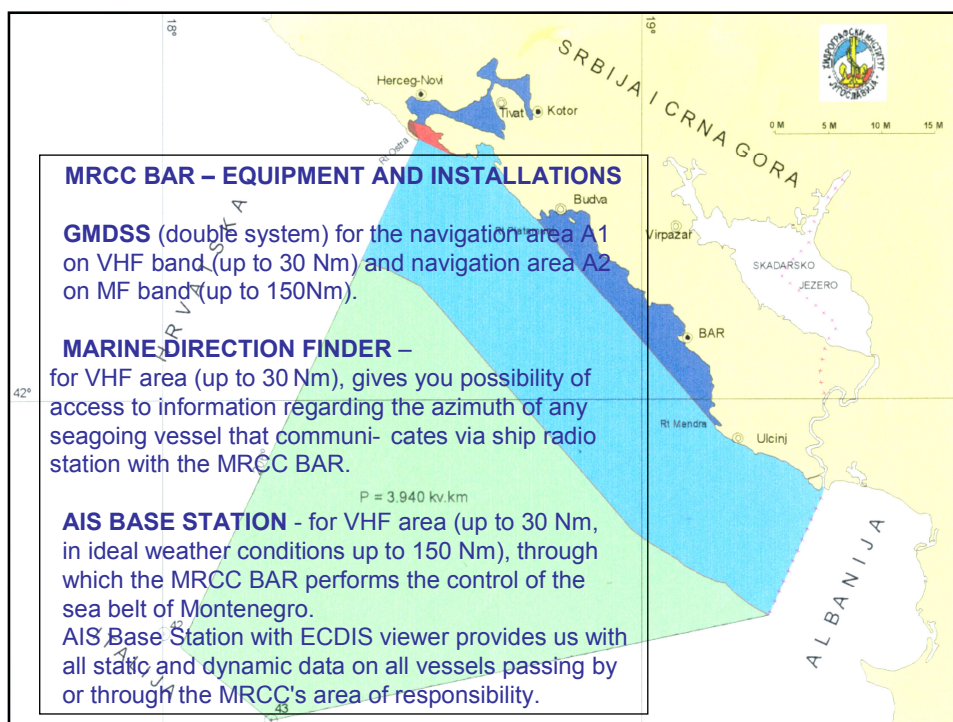

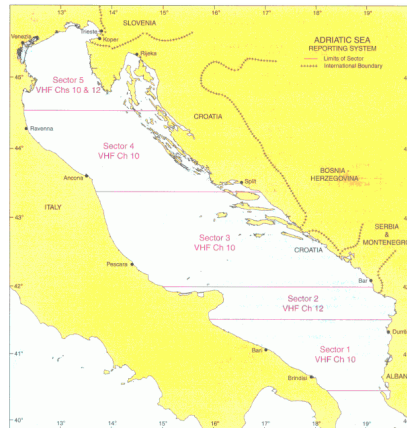
RESCUE BOAT OF THE MSD

## MANDATORY SHIP REPORTING SYSTEM IN ADRIATIC SEA

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE IMO RESOLUTION MSC.139(76), MARITIME RESCUE COORDINATION CENTER BAR (MRCC BAR) IS THE SHORE-BASED AUTHORITY RESPONSIBLE FOR RECEPTION AND FORWARDING OF REPORTS REGARDING MOVEMENTS OF SHIPS THROUGH THE SECTOR 2, AS PART OF THE MANDATORY SHIP REPORTING SYSTEM IN THE ADRIATIC SEA.

## FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

## **DRAFT LOW ON THE PREVENTION OF SEA POLLUTION FROM SEA-GOING VESSELS**

**DRAFT LOW ON THE PREVENTION OF SEA POLLUTION FROM SEA-GOING VESSELS IS CURRENTLY BEING DRAWN UP AND IS COMPLETELY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE:**

### **1. PROVISIONS OF MARPOL CONVENTION 73/78, AND ITS SIX ANNEXES.**

**THE FOLLOWING WAS TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION:**

- a) Classification of waste into: sludge, waste oil, oily mixture, oily waste, garbage, bilge water, sewage, ballast water, harmful substances, etc.;
- b) Responsibilities of ports to provide for adequate facilities and installations for reception and management of waste within their areas;
- c) Control of waste and harmful substances on ships entering, staying and leaving ports.

### **2. PROVISIONS OF THE OPRC CONVENTION 1990, OPRC-HNS PROTOCOL 2000 AND 2002, PROVISIONS OF PREVENTION AND EMERGENCY PROTOCOL TO THE BARCELONA CONVENTION 1995.**

All of which are concerned with preparedness, response and co-operation in case of marine pollution, from which the National Plan for Emergency Response stemmed.

### **3. PROVISIONS OF THE CLC CONVENTION 1992, FUND CONVENTION 1992, HNS CONVENTION 1996, BUNKERS CONVENTION 2001.**

All of which are concerned with liability and compensation for pollution damage caused by oil pollution.

## **DRAFT LOW ON THE PREVENTION OF SEA POLLUTION FROM SEA-GOING VESSELS**

**Article 79 = Directive 2000/59/EC, PORT RECEPTION FACILITIES**

**Article 71 = AFS 2001 Convention, REGULATION (EC) 782/2003**

**Article 48 = Directive 2002/59/EC, TRAFFIC MONITORING DIRECTIVE**

**Article 59 = Directive 2005/33/EC, SULPHUR CONTENT OF CERTAIN LIQUID FUELS**

**Article 13 = Directive 2002/59/EC, TRAFFIC MONITORING DIRECTIVE (Place of refuge)**

**Ballast water = EC Directive Regulation 2978/94**

**Penalties = Directive 2005/35/EC**



## DRAFT LOW ON THE MARITIME SAFETY AND SECURITY

DRAFT LOW ON THE MARITIME SAFETY AND SECURITY IS CURRENTLY BEING DRAWN UP AND IT WILL BRING SOME CHANGES IN MONTENEGRO MARITIME ORGANIZATION.

1. REGISTRATION OF BOATS, VESSELS AND OTHER NAVIGABLE OBJECTS WILL PASS FROM HARBOUR MASTER OFFICES TO MARITIME SAFETY DEPARTMENT.
2. MARINE SURVEY DIVISION OF MARITIME SAFETY DEPARTMENT WILL PASS TO FLAG STATE INSPECTION DIVISION.
3. ACCORDING TO IMO Res.A.739(18), IMO Res.A.789(19) AND EU DIRECTIVE 94/57/EC GOVERNMENT OF MONTENEGRO WILL AUTHORIZED CLASSIFICATION SOCIETY (IACS MEMBERS) AS RECOGNISED ORGANIZATION FOR STATUTARY SURVEY.
4. HARBOUR MASTER OFFICES WILL PERFORMS ACTIVITIES REGARDING:
  - a) PORT STATE CONTROL INSPECTION AND IMPROVE IT TO THE LEVEL OF PARIS MoU, AND
  - b) SEAFARERS EXAMINATIONS, ON WHICH BASE CERTIFICATES WILL BE ISSUED.
