



SHIPPING COMPANIES UPDATE



- Companies need to agree on the <u>responsible entity</u> for both ETS and MRV obligations
- If a Shipowner decides to delegate the responsibility to an **ISM Company**, need for <u>a mandate</u>
- Ship's Effective Date, the date since the ship has been under the company's responsibility





MONITORING PLAN (MP)



CHANGE

- mandatory to submit to the Administering Authority, after being assessed by the Verifier, and before 1 April 2024
- MP to be filled in and <u>submitted through THETIS-</u> MRV platform*

ROLE OF ADMINISTERING AUTHORITIES

SHIPPING COMPANIES ADMINISTERING AUTHORITIES (AA) Note: • authority responsible for administering the EU ETS in respect of a shipping company;

VERIFIERS

- Approve the Ship Monitoring Plan, after satisfactory assessment made by an accredited verifier.
- Receive the Ship Emission Report, after verification by an accredited verifier.
- Receive the report at company level, after verification by an accredited verifier.
- Ensure overall company compliance with MRV and ETS obligations.




SHIPPING COMPANIES

HOW?

Companies Registered at THETIS-MRV:

- a) EEA company -> the EEA Member State where the company is registered
- b) Non-EEA company -> the EEA Member State where there is the greatest number of port calls (last 4 preceding years)
- c) Non-EEA company and newcomer EEA Member State of the first port call



WHEN?

- By 1 February 2024, the Commission will publish the first attribution list
- If not on the list (e.g. new company), the shipping company will have to register at THETIS-MRV, assign ships, and request for the Attribution
- Then, every two years a new list is published





MONITORING PLAN (MP)

SAME PRINCIPLE, new features

- MP must be done and submitted only through THETIS-MRV
- Ships with MP already on THETIS-MRV can be updated, adding only the new data

MP – Template Annex I - EU 2016/1927 *Added requirements and new Tables:*

- ship sub-types
- emission sources types, and class
- fuel types,
- emission factors
- slippage coefficient, per emission source
- carbon capture and storage technologies
- procedures for data flow activities
- procedures for risk assessment

- energy efficiency indicator, consumption/ emission per time at sea

PART E ⁽²⁾ - Results from annual monitoring to follow ETS Directive

- determination of GHG emissions, and emissions derogation conditions:
 - Biomass, RFNBO and RCF
 - Voyage geographical scope
 - CCS/CCU
 - Small islands, outermost regions, public service
 - Ice class
 - Phase-in

REPORT AT COMPANY LEVEL (fleet level)



REPORT AT COMPANY LEVEL – new template to be adopted

Part A – Data identifying the company and the ships

• list of the ships, which are under the responsibility of the company

Part B – Verifier data

Part C – Aggregated emissions data at company level

- sum of all ships' total aggregated emissions of GHG to be reported under ETS Directive
- results for the purpose of submission to the Union Registry

Part D – Methodology used by the company to aggregate emissions data at company level

Partial Emission Report:

- Period? Emissions from 1 Jan to 1 March
- When? to be submitted as soon as possible to all relevant authorities, to Company B, and no later than 3 months after the change, also, release ship from THETIS-MRV

Emission Report:

- Period? Emissions from <u>1 Jan to 31</u>
 December
- When? By 31 March of the year after *

Report at Company Level:

- Allowances period? Emissions from <u>1 Jan to</u>
 <u>1 March for this ship</u>
- to be submitted to the Administering
 Authority by 31 March of the year after*

Report at Company Level:

- Allowances Period? Emissions from <u>1</u>
 March to 31 December for this ship
- to be submitted to the Administering
 Authority by 31 March of the year after*

VERIFIERS

VERIFIER Tasks



- Assessment of ship Monitoring Plan (MP) submitted by the shipping companies
 - MP changes, shall be re-assessed and re-submitted to Administering Authorities
- Assessment of the conformity of ship emission reports (ER), acc to 2016/1927 Annex II
- Verification of emission reports (ER)
- Verification of partial emission reports
 - Where there is a change of company, the verifier at the end of the year should not verify again the partial emission report at ship level
- Verification of reports at company level

Verifiers must follow amended Regulation EU 2016/2072 and be accredited by a National Accreditation Body pursuant to Regulation EC No. 765/2008


