Directive 2009/16/EC

Inspections shall be carried out only by inspectors who:

- fulfil the **qualification criteria** specified in the Directive

and

- are **authorized by MS** after verification of **qualification criteria** and **competences**.



Qualification criteria



but.....

MSs shall also:

- **ensure the PSCO training to maintain and improve competences**
- **periodically verify PSCO competences**

in the light of the “Harmonised Community Scheme**” for the training and assessment of competences**

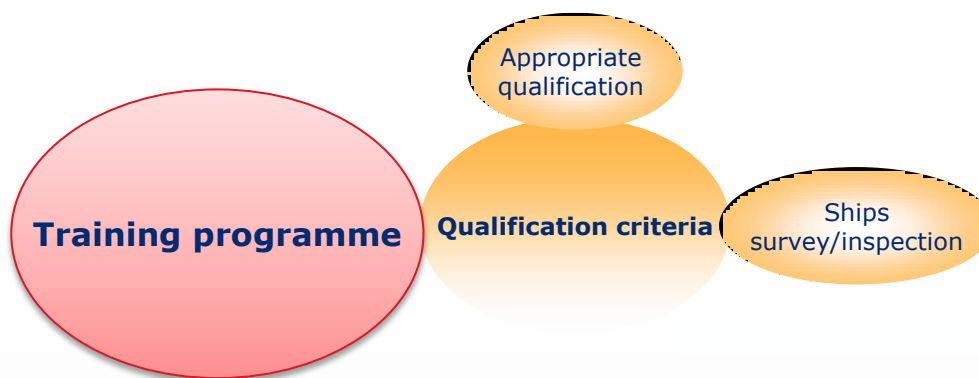
European Maritime Safety Agency

- **organises, where appropriate, relevant training activities in fields which are the responsibility of the Member States.**



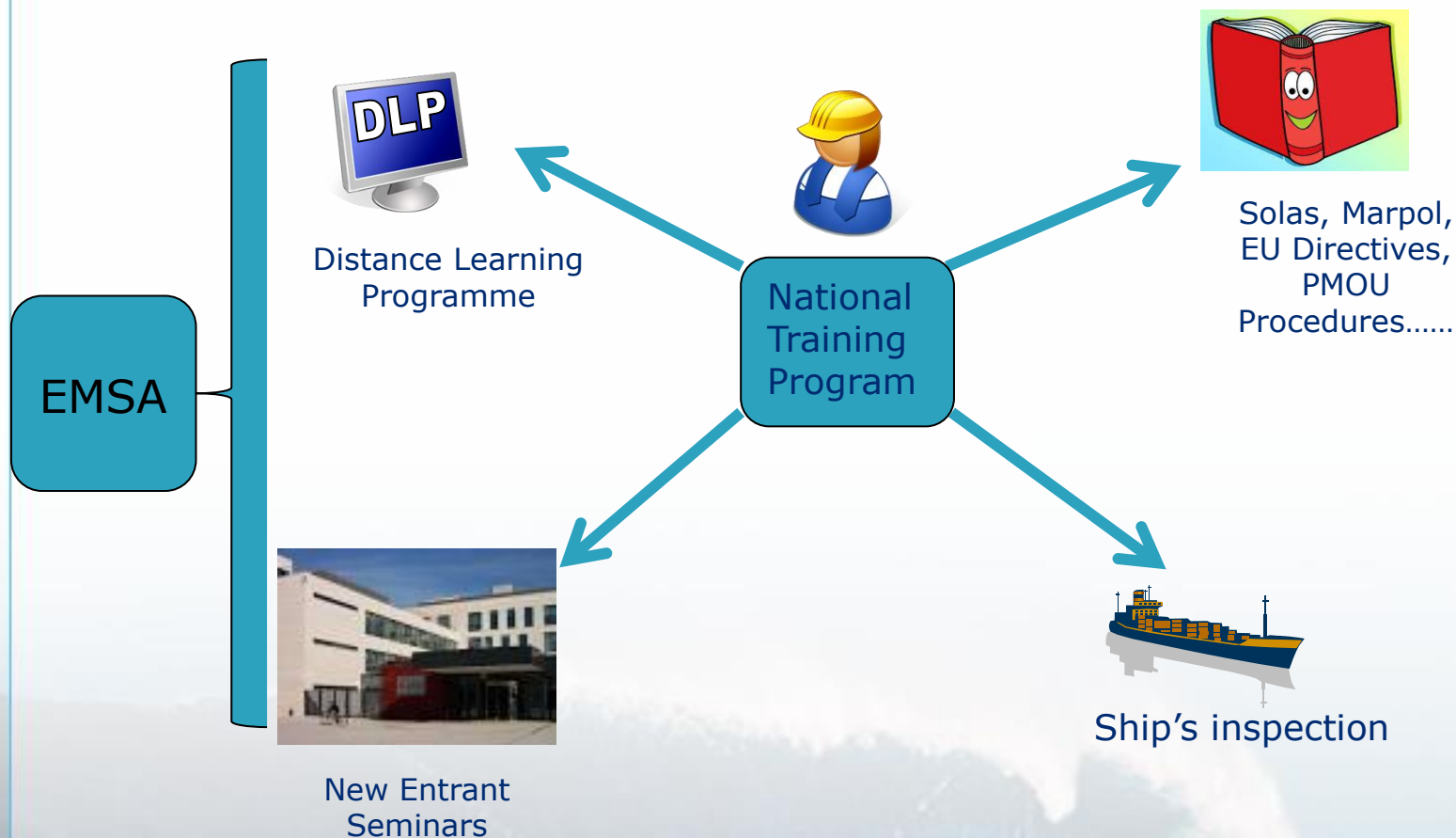
Harmonised Community Scheme

1. Syllabus of Competence (**SOC**) for new entrant PSCO

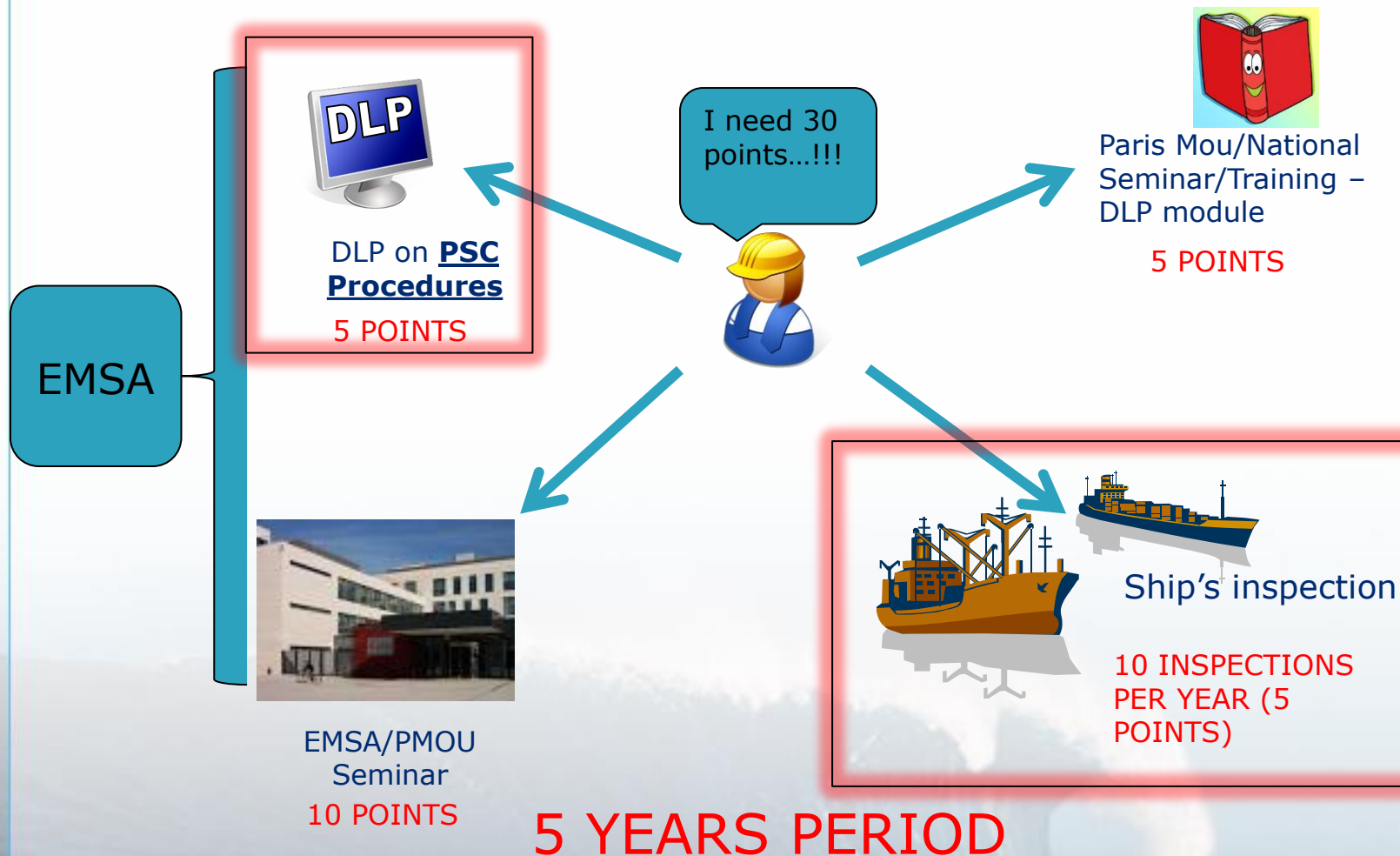


2. Professional Development Scheme (**PDS**)

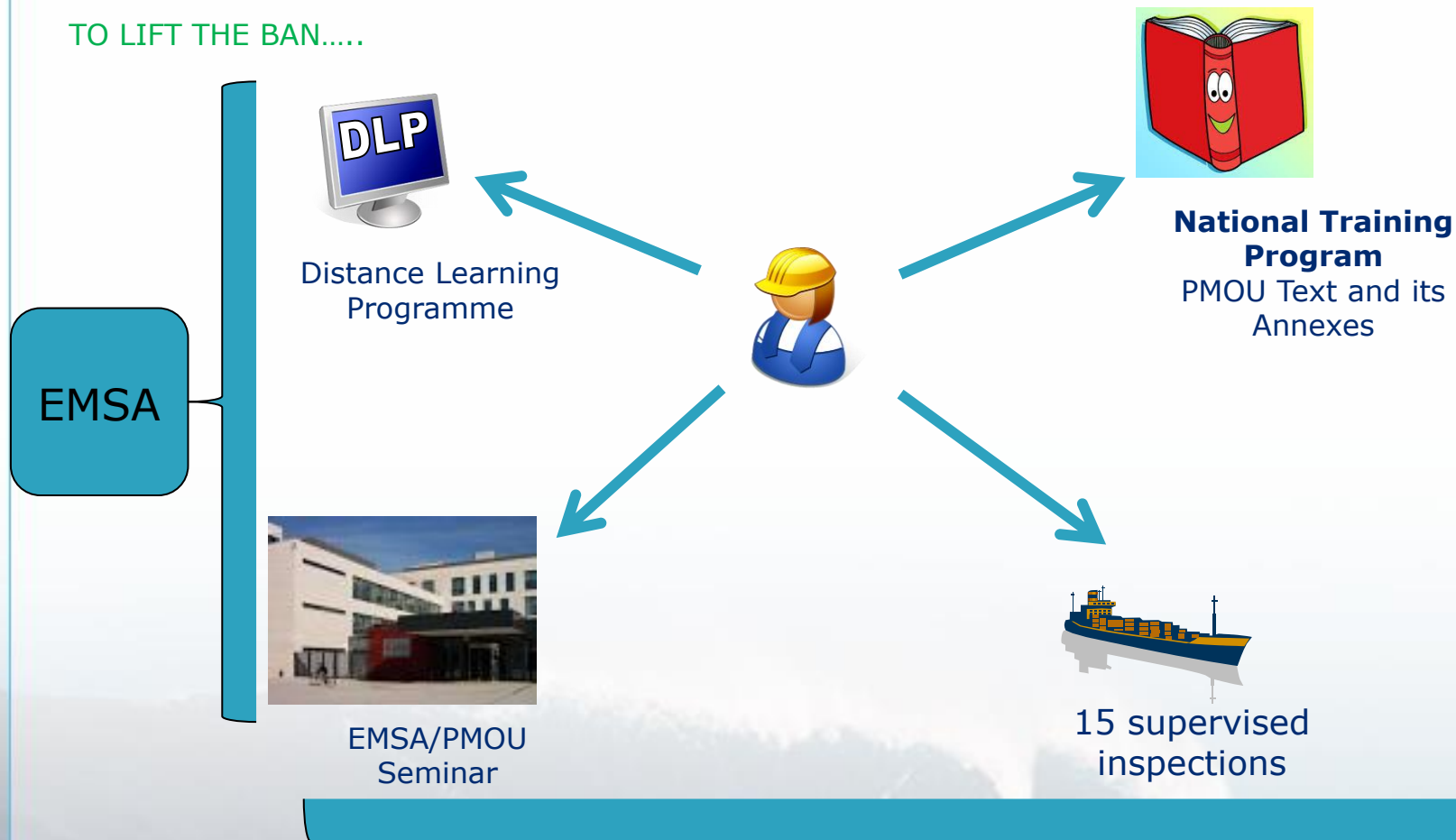
