Objectives of the Pilot Project for Equipment Donation to SAFEMED III beneficiary countries

- **To enhance the pollution response capacity of the non-European Union Mediterranean coastal countries**
- **To prevent escalation of a spill and mitigate the impact of the oil pollution into European waters**

1. Declassification of equipment
2. Overhauling and commissioning
3. Transport and temporary storage
4. To provide training services

SAFEMED III Beneficiary Countries tasks

1. Vessel(s) preparations
2. Storage, maintenance and training

Project Timeline: Administrative Steps

EMSA shall launch a Call for Proposals to select the SAFEMED III beneficiary countries: June - July 2014

- General objectives of the project;
- Detailed list of items and description of the status of the equipment and its operational features.

Candidates shall submit project proposal for the sustainable use of the equipment that shall include:

- o description of the vessel for the installation of the equipment;
- o plan for the equipment installation, storage and maintenance;
- o plan for future training activities.

Project Timeline: Administrative Steps

EMSA shall launch:

Call for Proposals for transportation, overhauling and commissioning of the equipment: June - July 2014

Call for the provision of training services: December 2014 – April 2015

Project Timeline: Implementation

- **Implementation of service contract for the provision of equipment transportation, overhauling, temporary storage, transfer to beneficiaries and commissioning: January - May 2015**
- **Preparation phase in beneficiary countries, including vessel(s) adaptations to receive the equipment, with EMSA technical support and monitoring: February - May 2015**

Project Timeline: Implementation

- **Implementation of the service contract for crew training: June – September 2015**
- **At-sea Exercise: September 2015**
- **Reporting on operational phase and lessons learned exercise: until June 2016**
