## Wrap-up and conclusions (1 of 3)

- There is positive appreciation of the integrated maritime services as delivered so far by IMDatE.
- There is strong support for further development of functionalities that can be used in daily operations.
- IMDatE is being used for a wide range of tasks including Search and Rescue, environmental monitoring, law enforcement and fleet monitoring.
- Strong support for global satellite AIS feed.
- Shown that IMDatE is able to handle complex data access rights however there is a need to address governance issues in general.

## Wrap-up and conclusions (2 of 3)

- A number of operational and technical requirements have been requested. Some software issues have been raised. EMSA will propose a schedule to address these.
- New requirements include:
  - Future integration with remaining SSN data sets.
  - PSC and SSN information.
  - GIS features.
- Data sources:
  - Met-ocean information – a number of requests for this information to be integrated.
  - Ship-borne radar
  - Coastal radar
  - Patrol assets (aircraft and vessels)

## Wrap-up and conclusions (3 of 3)

- Thank the participants for a very active and fruitful discussion during our first workshop. Your contribution and feedback is essential for the evolution of the IMDatE services!
- MS are requested to express their needs for training and/or information sessions
- EMSA re-iterates that IMDatE should be used to complement national systems and not as a replacement.
