On 3 June 2004, the European Commission (at the time DG TREN) requested from the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) a technical input supporting the forthcoming new legislative proposals on maritime safety.

A **report** was prepared showing how EU Member States had organised their maritime administrations and how the respective bodies implemented their obligations under the International Conventions and EU legislation.

Information about the Icelandic and Norwegian maritime administrations was also included.

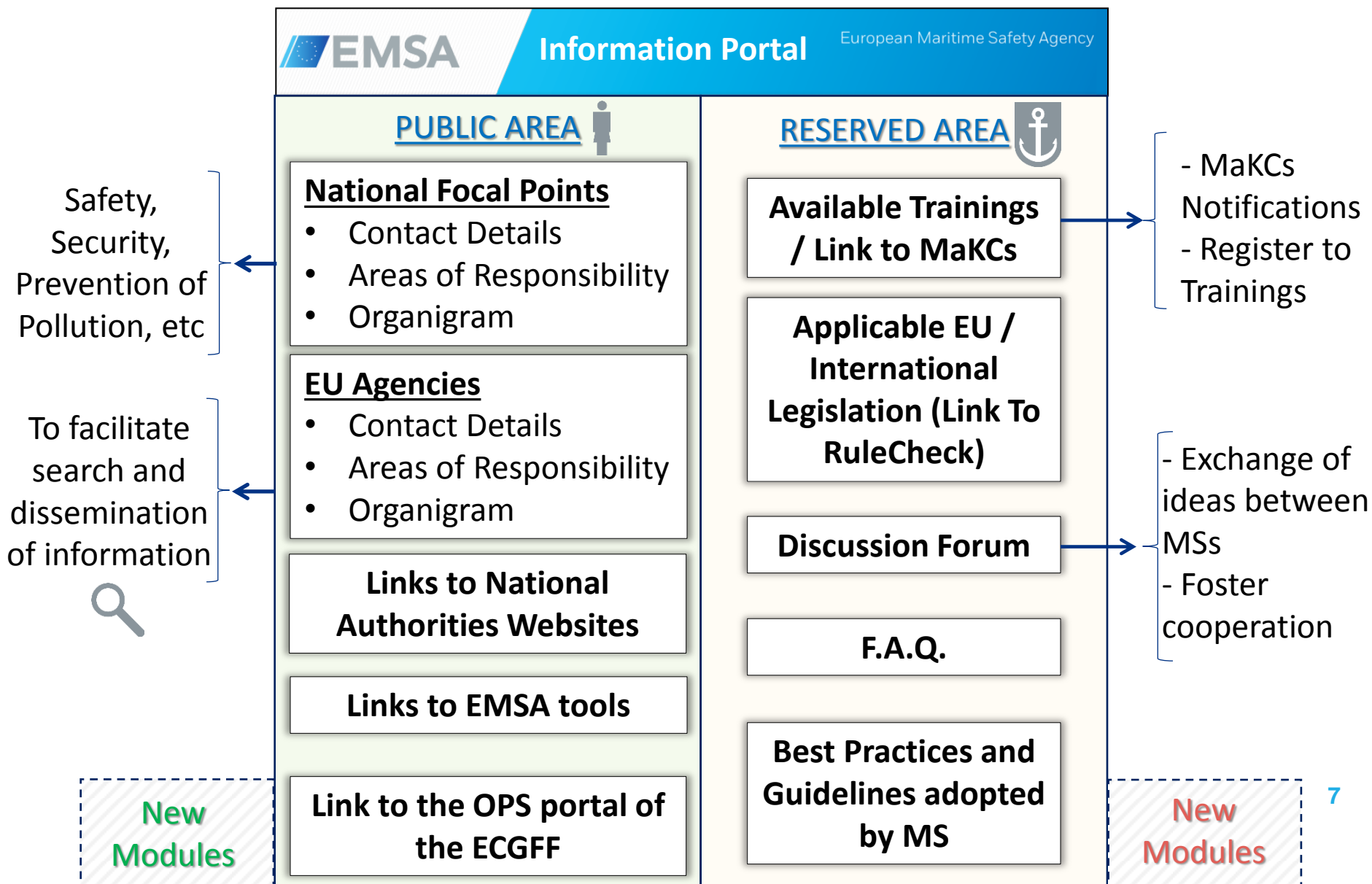
MSs have invited **EMSA** through **CNTA** to propose a **dynamic approach**

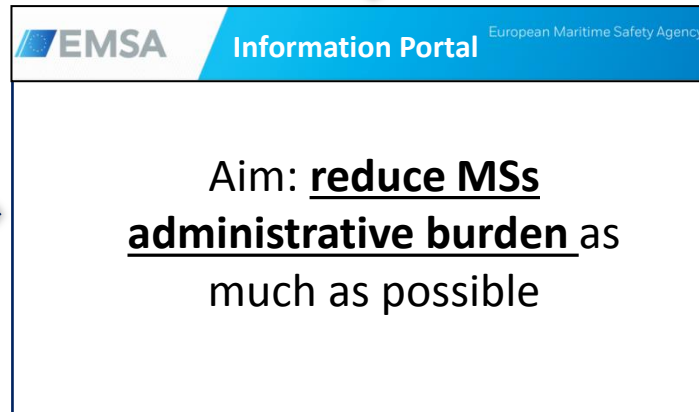
Proposal: Information Portal



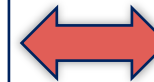
- Updated periodically by EMSA

- Exchange of Information with EMSA Maritime Applications (THETIS, THETIS-EU, SSN, etc):



- Engage in a dialog with relevant organisations for the exchange of information: IMO GISIS, ILO, etc



- keep the portal updated from existing in-house sources and vice-versa
