Question 04 (dated 15 September 2017, 15:30):

Regarding the maximum budget available for this procurement for EUR 420,000 Euro excluding VAT is for the overall maximum delivery 10 (ten) shore-based AIS stations and a maximum of 4 (four) Central nodes including HW?

Answer to question 04:

Yes, the maximum budget includes maximum 10 (ten) shore-based AIS stations and a maximum of 4 (four) Central nodes including HW.

Question 05 (dated 15 September 2017, 15:30):

Does the specified budget of EUR 420,000 includes the costs that will be associated the “Specific Contract” (transport and ancillary services) or that counts with a separate budget?

Answer to question 05:

No there is no ‘separate budget’. The maximum available budget of EUR 420,000 will be ‘consumed’ via separate Specific contracts implementing the Framework contract. The available budget will cover all the AIS stations, the nods, the transportation and the ancillary services.

Question 06 (dated 15 September 2017, 15:30):

Does the budget of EUR 420,000 includes additional services once the equipment is delivered and installed at ENP Partner companies (for example IP configurations, network, etc.) or such work will be done by ENP countries?

Answer to question 06:

No, the additional services mentioned are not part of this tender and are also excluded from the maximum amount of the available budget.

Question 07 (dated 22 September 2017,14:48):

The tender specification states the sites to be equipped with a UPS battery backup, supporting an operation time of 30 hours. To guarantee 30 hours operation with a battery UPS system would require very large and heavy equipment, and the costs become very high.

Can EMSA please confirm whether the requested UPS battery backup time requirement is 30 hours per site, or if it perhaps should be 30 minutes per site?

Answer to question 07:

Under paragraph 2.2.1 of the Tender Specifications it is stated that **‘Each shore-based AIS station shall include the following components’:**

[...]

f	UPS	Backup power supply unit including batteries (battery operation approx. 30 hours)	1
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Therefore, yes, we can confirm that the intended UPS battery backup should be 30 hours (or approximately that length of time). We do not consider that 30 min. would be an appropriate approximation of the length of time needed for the UPS battery support.
