Compliance steps in 2025

The shipping company perspective in respect of 2024 emissions



31 December 2024: ETS Maritime first monitoring year ends

As soon as possible and **no later than 31 March 2025**: submission of verified end of year ship-level emissions reports (ER) and company-level emissions reports (CER) through THETIS-MRV

By **31 March 2025**: have emissions in the Union Registry MOHA marked as verified

By **30 September 2025**: surrender the due EU allowances in the Union Registry



If the shipping company does not meet the legal deadlines it will be non-compliant with the legislative requirements under MRV/ETS
