

## Decision No. 2025/024 of the Executive Director relating to public holidays for 2026

The Executive Director of the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA), having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities and in particular to Article 61 thereto.

Having regard to the Commission Decision C(2025) 4899 final;

Having consulted the Staff Committee;

Whereas it is relevant to consider the public holidays in Portugal,

Has decided:

Article 1

The following days will be considered public holidays in 2026:

1 January Thursday, New Year's Day

2 January Friday, day following New Year

2 April Maundy Thursday

3 April Good Friday

6 April Easter Monday

1 May Friday, Labour Day

14 May Thursday, Ascension Day

15 May Friday, Day after Ascension Day

10 June Wednesday, Portugal Day2 November Monday, All Souls' Day

1 December Tuesday, Portuguese Restoration of Independence Day

23 to 31 December End of year (7 days)

TOTAL: 18 Days

## Article 2

Work will resume as normal on Monday, 4 January 2027.

## Article 3

The Executive Director reserves the right to establish a minimum service during the public holidays, should the needs of the service so require.

## Article 4

Subject to the Commission Decision on holiday flexibility arrangements due to be published at the beginning of 2026, the expected dates under the holiday flexibility arrangements of the implementing provisions on leave and absences applied to the Agency by analogy are expected to be:

2 April 2026 Maundy Thursday

3 April 2026 Good Friday

15 May 2026 Day after Ascension Day
