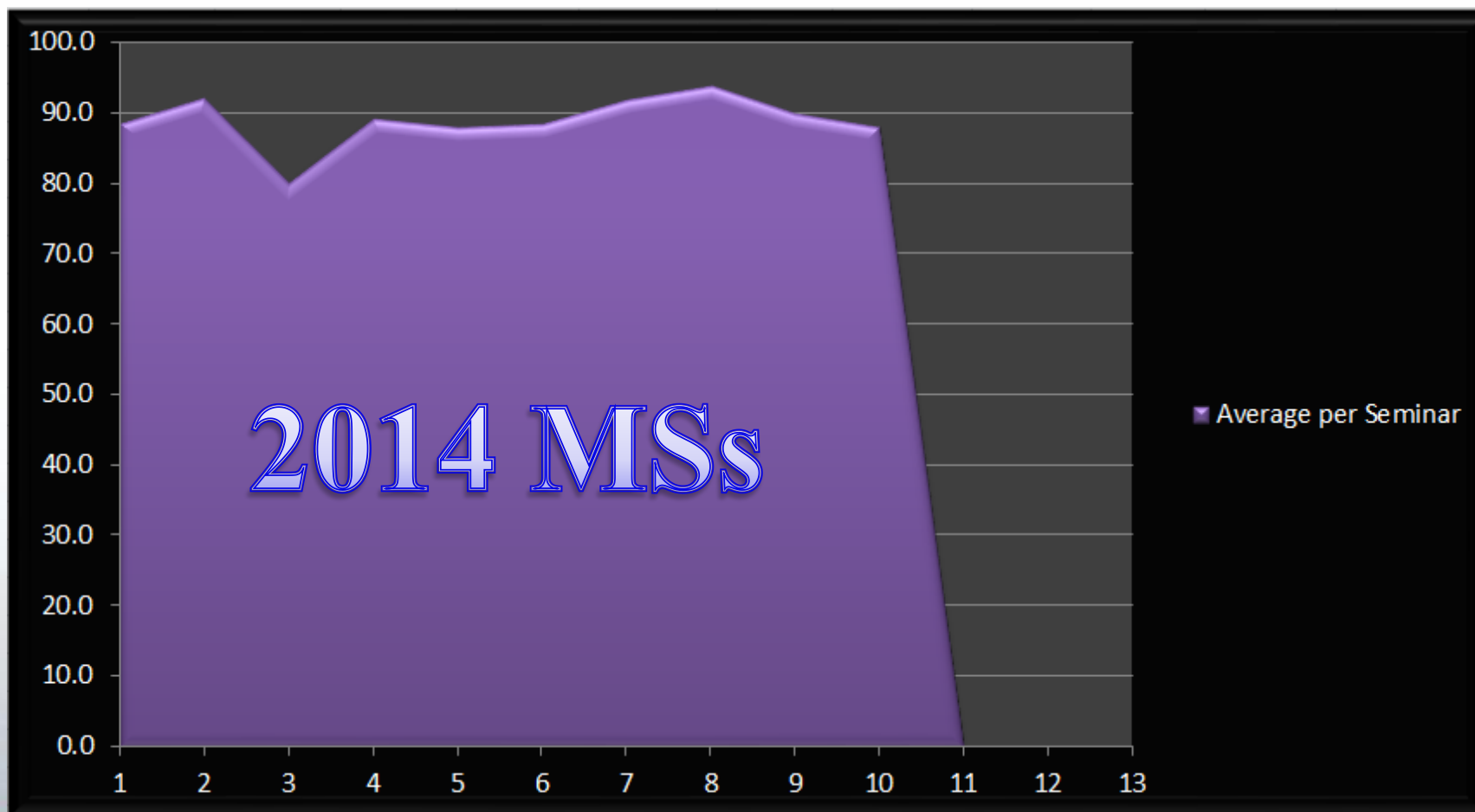

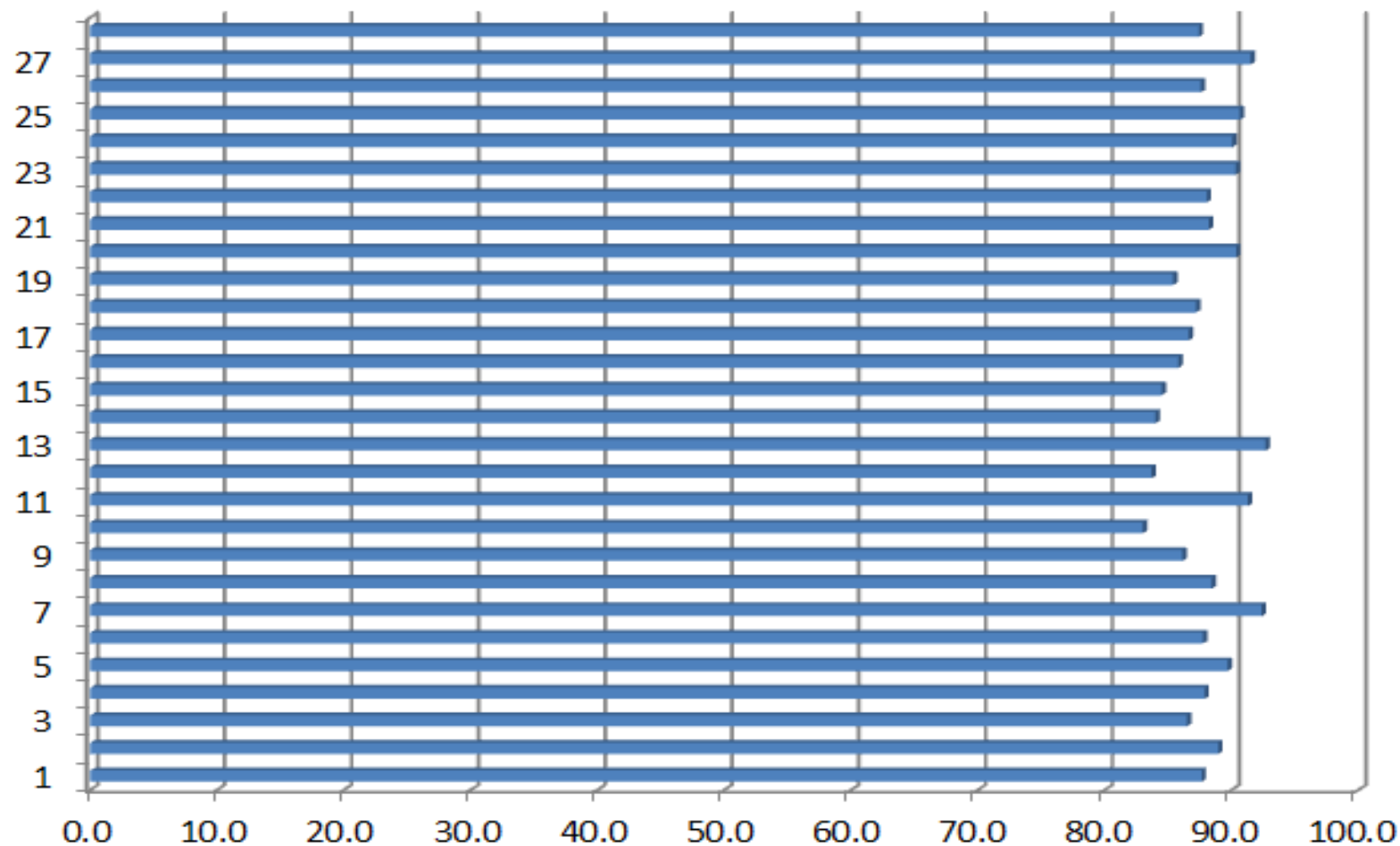

Under PHARE, CARDS & IPA

Second Contribution Agreement for Preparatory Measures for the Participation of Candidates & Potential Candidate Countries in EMSA's Work

Grant: **300 000 euros**

Programme's duration: 35 months (October '11– September '14)

Beneficiaries:

- **Albania**
- **Bosnia & Herzegovina,**
- **Croatia,**
- **Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia**
- **Montenegro,**
- **Serbia, and**
- **Turkey**

Main objectives:

- **Aligning national maritime legislation with EU maritime acquis**
- **Building administrative capacity within the national administrations, capable to implement & enforce this legislation**

Second Contribution Agreement for Preparatory Measures for the Participation of Candidates & Potential Candidate Countries in EMSA's Work (cont.)

Specific objectives:

- Spread knowledge on EU maritime acquis outside the Union
- Raise the level of awareness for improving maritime safety, security, pollution prevention/response
- Promote and Facilitate adoption, implementation & enforcement of EU maritime standards by beneficiaries
- Boost expertise and organisational capacity to implement EU legislation

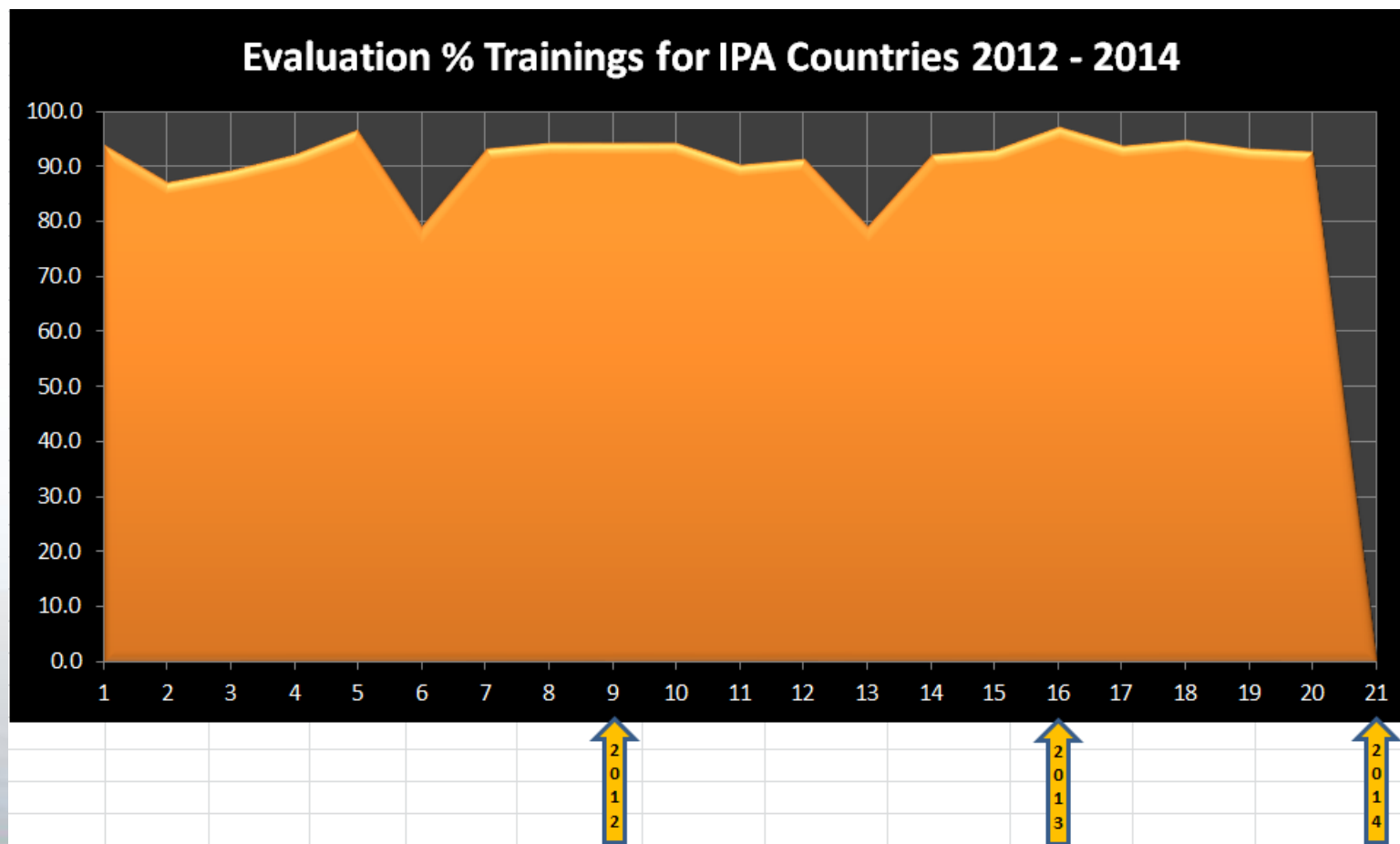
