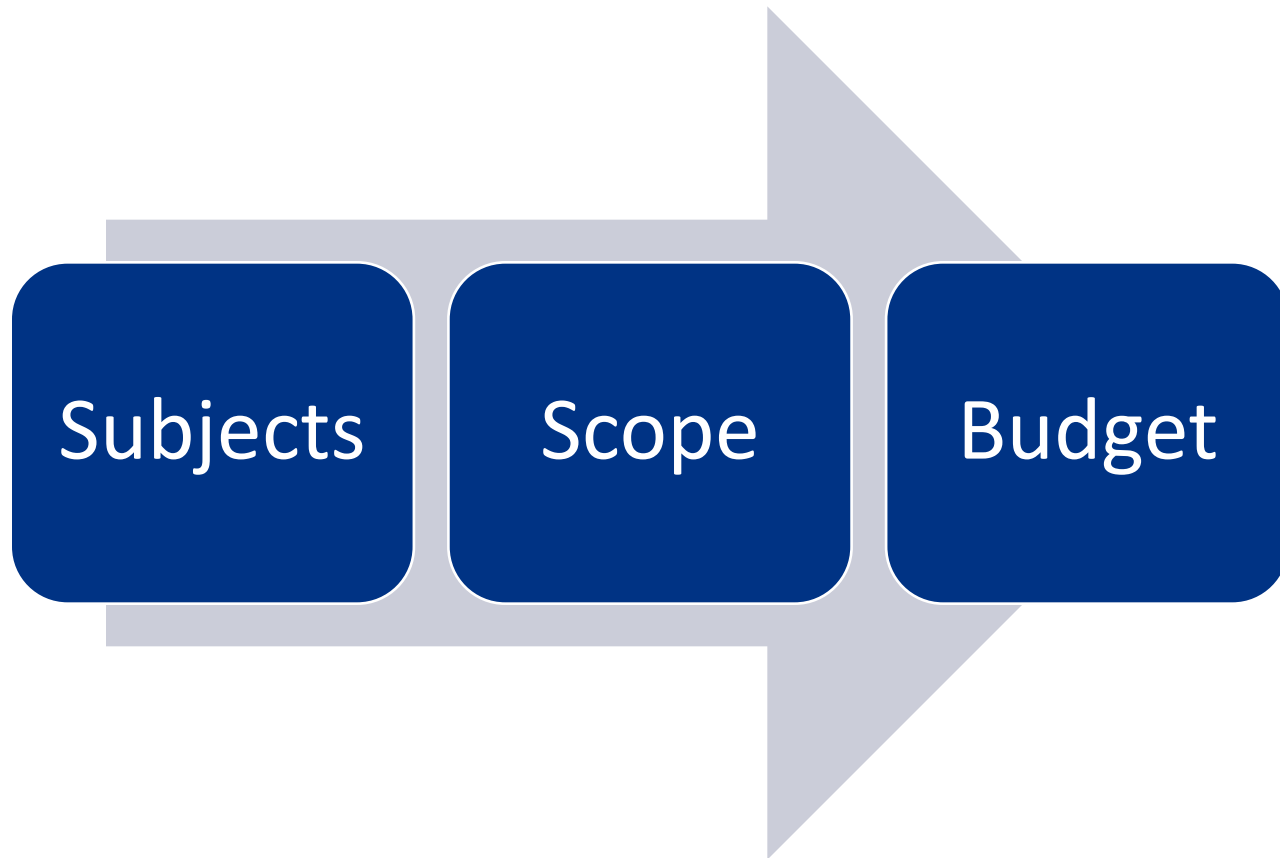

EMSA training proposals for 2016

1. EU Maritime Legislation (basic)
2. EU Maritime Legislation for Environmental issues
3. ISM Code & Auditing Techniques (delivered by an external contractor)
4. ISPS Code (delivered by an external contractor)
5. STCW Convention (New comers)
6. STCW Convention (Advanced)
7. Monitoring of the RSOs

Training on EU Maritime legislation

- **3.5 working days**
- Participants gain insight into European maritime legislation and its interaction with international laws and conventions
- Workshops, multiple choice tests help participants to understand more about the enforcement of EU legislation
- The training is primarily addressed to officials that have just commenced working within their national administrations and will deal with EU maritime issues, and other staff who would like to broaden their knowledge



Training on EU Environmental legislation

- **2 working days**
- To provide the participants with a closer overview on the whole European Maritime Environmental Legislation
- The training is primarily addressed to officials that have recently commenced working within their national administrations and will deal with EU environmental maritime legislation, or are working on other fields and wish to expand their knowledge



Training on ISM Code & Auditing techniques

- **4 working days**
- The course will help to ensure that participants are familiar with the ISM Code, including the different types of audits (Flag State, RO and internal audit), and will develop a practical approach to the interpretation and application of the ISM Code
- The participants will be Flag and Port State Control officers from the maritime administrations of the Member States
- It is provided by an external contractor (DNV-GL)



Training on ISPS Code

- **4 working days**
- The course will ensure that participants are familiar with the main elements of ISPS, auditing procedures, and can develop a practical approach to the interpretation and application of the ISPS Code
- The participants will be officials from the administrations of countries involved in the monitoring and control of compliance of security measures on board ships and companies.
- It is provided by a new external contractor (Regs4Ships)



Training on STCW Convention (New comers)

- **4 working days**
- The course will provide participants with an overview on the STCW Convention and Code and the relevant EU Directives
- It is addressed to maritime administrations' staff that has recently started working on STCW related matters, or those working on other areas and wishing to familiarize with it



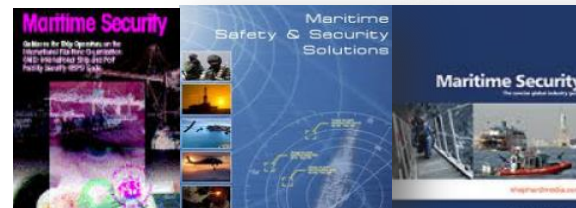
Training on STCW Convention (Advanced)

- **4 working days**
- The course will provide participants with a more deep overview on the STCW Convention and Code and the relevant EU Directives
- It is addressed to maritime administrations' staff already working on STCW related matters wishing to expand their level of knowledge



Training on Monitoring of the RSOs

- 1 working day
- The course will **address both the regulatory and technical aspects of delegation of ISPS Code related tasks to Recognised Security Organisations (RSOs)** with specific focus on the obligations of the maritime administrations in respect of delegation, monitoring and auditing of such Organisations.
- Through the **sharing of best practices with some selected EU Member States and cases study**, the seminar aims to enable participants to develop a practical approach to monitoring and auditing of RSOs.



Practical Training on Ship & Port facility Security aspects

- **3 working days**
- Includes a review of the current Security Legislation as well as case studies
- Training for participants already involved on the implementation and monitoring of the security maritime legislation



Training for inspectors implementing EU Environmental legislation not covered by International Conventions

- **2 working days**
- The training will focus on inspection requirements stemming from EU Environmental legislation, going beyond the provisions of the international Conventions
- Suitable for staff involved with the implementation of EU Environmental legislation and in particular ship inspections



Training on Ship recycling Regulation

- **2 working days**
- The training session will focus on the recent EU legislation and the International Convention on Ship recycling
- Developed for Maritime Administrations' staff involved with recycling issues



Simulated ISM Audit for passenger ships

- **2 working days**
- Recent accidents with passenger ships
- The course shall ensure that participants develop a practical approach on passenger ships audit techniques and become aware of the latest changes to the ISM Code and guidelines
- The participants will be Flag and Port State Control Officers from the Maritime Administrations of the Member States, with basic knowledge/training the ISM Code. The training contains a simulated audit on a passenger ship with a set of case studies and possible problems encountered



Training on Enforcement Provisions of the Sulphur Directive

- **2 working days**
- **The training will be a repetition of the one delivered in 2015, funded from DG ENV**
- The course will provide an overview of the requirements prescribed in the Directive as well as guidance in the performance of Sulphur Inspections and eventual reporting in THETIS
- Is addressed to officials from the EU Maritime Administrations or any other Competent Authorities within the Member States with responsibilities on the enforcement of EU Directive 2012/33



Core skill course for Accidents Investigation

- **5 working days**
- This course is designed for those who will conduct, or participate in, marine accident safety investigations in accordance with Directive 2009/18/EC.
- This training course presents the basic elements of conducting a safety investigation. It covers interviewing witnesses, and analyzing human factors and underlying conditions. The course will not only provide theoretical material, but also practical training to enable participants to practice the tools taught



PSCOs seminars

- **4 working days**
- This course is designed for PSCOs in accordance with Directive 2009/16/EC
- This training course is compulsory under the above instrument and four seminars will be held at EMSA premises for 2016
