On 3 June 2004, the European Commission (DG TREN) requested from the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) a technical input supporting the forthcoming new legislative proposals on maritime safety.

A **report** was prepared showing how EU Member States had organised their maritime administrations and how the respective bodies implemented their obligations under the International Conventions and EU legislation.

Information about the Icelandic and Norwegian maritime administrations was also included.

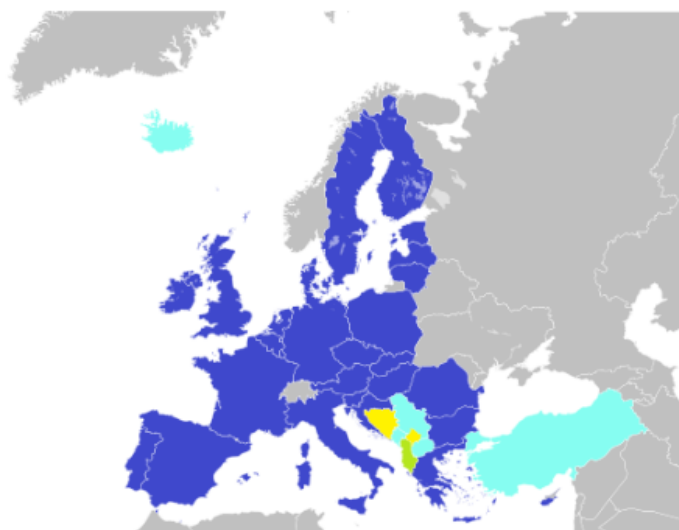

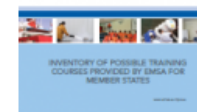
