Procurement procedure: EMSA/NEG/13/2016

Question 01 (dated 19 May 2016, 12.13):

We just found out there is an on-site visit planned on May 19 or 20... Is this mandatory?

Answer to question 01:

No, the visit is not mandatory, it is at the tenderer's discretion if he wants to schedule such a visit in the foreseen period (please refer to the Invitation to Tender document).

Question 02 (dated 23 May 2016, 19.40):

- 1) In tender specifications you ask for the “accreditation by the Instituto dos Mercados Públicos do Imobiliário e da Construção – to have „Alvará de Licenciamento – Classe 3, 4a Categoria – Instalações e mecânicas“. This is discriminatory. Can we present some comparable national certificate? Which one?
- 2) We are not officially certified by ISO but we are using equivalent methods/appropriate procedure during recycling process. Is it sufficient?

Answer to question 02:

- 1) Equivalent certification is always accepted. Comparable national certificates, issued by the competent authority at national level, attesting the fact that a company is authorized to perform installation services of electrical equipment (class 3 4th category - Electrical installations up to of 60 kV), are accepted as equivalents.
- 2) Equivalent certifications to the ISO standards are always accepted. Please refer to Point 13.4.1 in the Tender Specifications.
