

Invitation to Submit a Purchase Proposal No. EMSA/SA/2/2025 Sale of EMSA official car

Dear Sir/Madam,

1. The European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) is planning to sell the Asset(s) referred to above. The Sale of Assets documents consist of this invitation, the Call for Purchase Proposals, the Purchase Proposal Form, the draft Sale Contract and the Potential Buyer's checklist.
2. Potential Buyers who wish to submit a Purchase Proposal are invited to send it to the Agency. The time limit for receipt of the Purchase Proposal is on 17/06/2025 at 12h00 (Lisbon time).
3. Purchase Proposals may be sent:

a) by e-mail

To the following address: SA22025@emsa.europa.eu. The size of the mail may not exceed 12 Mb per one e-mail. The document "Purchase Proposal" **shall be password protected**. In order to submit a Purchase Proposal please follow the instructions in the "**Submission of Password Protected Purchase Proposal**". **Failure to submit a password protected document by e-mail will lead to the rejection of the Purchase Proposal.**

b) by hand-delivery in a closed envelope

A dated and signed receipt issued by a staff member of EMSA **shall be requested by the person delivering the Purchase Proposal** as proof of delivery.

In particular during the visit described in **Point 7.A.(iv)**, a Purchase Proposal template will be made available at EMSA and may be submitted then.

The Purchase proposal shall be submitted in a **closed envelope**, marked as follows:

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Failure to submit the Purchase Proposal in a closed envelope will lead to the rejection of the Purchase Proposal.

4. The period of validity of the Purchase Proposal, during which Potential Buyer may not modify the terms of their Purchase Proposal in any respect shall be 3 months.

5. Submission of a Purchase Proposal implies full acceptance of all the terms and conditions set out in the Sale of Assets documents and, where appropriate, waiver of the Potential Buyer's own general or specific terms and conditions.
6. All costs incurred during the preparation and submission of Purchase Proposals are to be borne by the Potential Buyers and will not be reimbursed.
7. Contact between the Agency and Potential Buyers is prohibited throughout the procedure, save in exceptional circumstances and under the following conditions only:

A. Before the final date for submission of Purchase Proposals:

- (i) At the request of the Potential Buyer, EMSA may provide additional information solely for the purpose of clarifying the Sale of Assets documents.

Any requests for additional information must be made in writing and sent to the following e-mail address: SA22025@emsa.europa.eu.

EMSA is not bound to reply to requests for additional information made less than six working days before the deadline for submission of Purchase Proposals¹.

- (ii) EMSA may, on its own initiative, inform interested parties of any error, inaccuracy, omission or any other clerical error in the Sale of Assets documents.
- (iii) Any additional information including that referred to above will be published on EMSA's website in the Procurement section.
- (iv) Potential Buyers are offered the possibility to attend an 'Assets Visit' between 03/06/2025 and 04/06/2025 at EMSA premises, Praça Europa No 4 1249-206 Lisbon, Portugal in order to view the asset.

Should you wish to attend, please send a request at the latest on 02/06/2025 indicating the name of the attending person and the Potential Buyer they represent to the following e-mail: SA22025@emsa.europa.eu. Personnel attending, as identified in the email, will be provided with precise logistical details in due time.

B. After the opening of Purchase Proposals:

- (i) If clarification is required or if obvious clerical errors in the Purchase Proposal need to be corrected, EMSA may contact the Potential Buyer.
8. This invitation to submit Purchase Proposals is in no way binding on EMSA. EMSA contractual obligation commences only upon signature of the Sale Contract with the successful Buyer(s).
9. Up to the point of signature, EMSA may cancel the procedure, without Potential Buyers being entitled to claim any compensation. This decision must be substantiated and Potential Buyers notified.
10. Once EMSA has opened the Purchase Proposal, the document(s) shall become the property of EMSA and it shall be treated confidentially.

11. Potential Buyers will be informed of the outcome of this procedure by e-mail. It is the Potential Buyers' responsibility to provide a valid e-mail address together with their contact details in their Purchase Proposal and to check this e-mail address regularly.
12. If processing a reply to the invitation to submit a Purchase Proposal involves the recording and processing of personal data (such as name, address and CV), the data will be processed pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council². Unless indicated otherwise, replies to Potential Buyers and any personal data requested, shall be used to evaluate the Purchase Proposal in accordance with the specifications of the invitation to submit a Purchase Proposal and will be processed solely for that purpose by the Head of Unit 4.2 - Legal, Finance and Facilities.

14. In addition to entities established in the Member States of the Union, only entities from the following countries are eligible to participate in the present procedure: Albania, Republic of North Macedonia, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Montenegro, Norway, Kosovo, Serbia and Bosnia and Herzegovina.
15. Participation to this Sale of Assets is open on equal terms to international organisations...
