DECISION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD *of 10/03/05*

AMENDING THE ESTABLISHMENT PLAN 2005 OF THE EUROPEAN MARITIME SAFETY AGENCY

EMSA ESTABLISHMENT PLAN 2005

The Administrative Board of the European Maritime Safety Agency,

Having regard to the European Parliament and Council Regulation 1406/2002, of 27 June 2002, setting up a European Maritime Safety Agency (hereafter EMSA or the Agency);

Having regard to the Financial Regulations of the Agency adopted by the Administrative Board on 3 July 2003 and in particular article 32 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The establishment plan of the Agency for 2005 was amended by the European Parliament in second reading (amendment 267).
- (2) The Agency is in its start-up phase and needs experienced staff to carry out its tasks.
- (3) Article 32 of the EMSA Financial Regulation allows the modification of the establishment plan by a decision of the Administrative Board under condition that no more than 10% of the posts are affected, that there is no need for additional budgetary provisions and that the total number of posts authorised is not exceeded.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1


The EMSA Establishment plan 2005 shall be modified as follows:

1. Four Temporary Agent positions A*5 are upgraded to A*8.
2. One Temporary position at B*8 is downgraded to B*6.
3. Two temporary Agent positions at B*7 are downgraded to B*4.
4. Two temporary Agent positions at B*6 are downgraded to B*3.

Article 2

The present decision will enter into force on the day of its signature.
