DECISION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD

of 18th November 2010

General provisions for implementing Article 87 (1) of the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants

The Administrative Board of the European Maritime Safety Agency,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities (CEOS), laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, EURATOM, ECSC) No 259/68, and in particular to Articles 43 of the Staff Regulations and 87 (1) of the Conditions of Employment,

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EC) n° No $1406/2002^{1}$ of 27 June 2002 establishing the European Maritime Safety Agency, and in particular article 6 thereof.

Having regard to the Commission Decision C(2006)1503 of 3 April 2006 concerning the agreement to certain Agencies on their implementing rules for giving effect to the Staff Regulations.

Having regard to the decision of the Administrative Board of EMSA of 24 November 2006 on general provisions for implementing Article 43 of the Staff Regulations,

After consultation of the Staff Committee and in agreement with the European Commission pursuant to Article 110 of the Staff Regulations,

ARTICLE 1

The decision of the Administrative Board of EMSA of 24 November 2006 on general provisions for implementing Article 43 of the Staff regulations applicable to officials and temporary agents is to be applied by analogy to contract staff referred to in Article 3a of the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants engaged for a period of not less than one year.
