## **DECISION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD APPOINTING THE DEPUTY ACCOUNTING OFFICER**

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN MARITIME SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union;

Having regard to the European Parliament and Council Regulation 1406/2002, of 27 June 2002, as amended, establishing a European Maritime Safety Agency (hereafter EMSA or the Agency);

Having regard to the Financial Regulation of the Agency adopted by the Administrative Board on 25 July 2019 and in particular Article 50(1) thereof (hereinafter 'EMSA's Financial Regulation');

Having regard to the Decision of the EMSA Administrative Board to appoint an Accounting Officer of 6 June 2024;

Whereas Ms Katalin Duarte is appointed as EMSA's Accounting Officer;

Whereas there is a need to ensure business continuity in case of unexpected or prolonged absences of the EMSA Accounting Officer, by means of appointment of a Deputy Accounting Officer;

Whereas the Deputy Accounting Officer shall be appointed by the Administrative Board on the basis of their particular competence as evidenced by diplomas or by equivalent professional experience;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

### **Article 1**

Mr Andreas Miltos is hereby appointed as EMSA's Deputy Accounting Officer.

### **Article 2**

Mr Andreas Miltos shall exercise the duties and responsibilities of the Deputy Accounting Officer in accordance with relevant provisions of EMSA's Financial Regulation and the terms and scope agreed between FRA and EMSA.

### **Article 3**

The present decision will apply as of 1 July 2025.
